Dear Parents and Guardians

This is an outline of the level and purpose of fees for students attending John Therry High School in 2017. Government Funding covers

Tuition Fee	Teachers' salaries and the day to day running costs of the school (water, electricity, paper etc)
Building Fund	This is a contribution used solely for the repayment of loans on the school buildings. (Equivalent to a mortgage payment)
Student Administration Fee	Covers the cost of the school planner issued to each student and other general administration costs.
Pastoral and Reflection Days	Covers the costs involved in running pastoral/reflection days. These days are part of the Pastoral program to promote positive
Technology Levy	This contributes towards the costs of maintaining technology hardware, software, access to the internet and apps for iPad's.
Subject Resource Fee	This covers the cost of all other books, consumables and equipment which are purchased in bulk and issued to your child for
Sports Fee	The sports levy covers most costs associated with travelling to sport and external coaches/instructors that visit John
Parents & Friends Levy	The P&F Levy has replaced fundraising events. The P&F Levy contributes to one or more major projects in the school year. Term 1 Caritas Term 2 St Vincent de Paul Winter Appeal Term 3 Marist Solidarity Term 4 St Vincent de Paul Christmas Appeal
